From the Church of the East to the Relationship between Jingjiao and the Nestorians

Abstract: Jingjiao has always been regarded as Nestorian faction in China. This argument seems to mean that Nestorianism spread directly to China. However, historically, Jingjiao was only a branch of the Church of the East spreading into China.
